COMMITMENT TO DISCIPLINE

The responsibility to instill discipline in the life of the child resides primarily with the parents. However, through its task in education the School will partner with the parents to maintain and manage this discipline in conduct and behaviour. A detailed copy of the School's Policy on Discipline is available on request. By attending Young Eagles Christian Academy it is required of learners to fully commit to and comply with the basic requirements as stipulated below:

1. Fully support and protect the School's Christian Ethos, Standards and Values.
2. Have respect for the Bible as the Word of God and to make it a part of his / her life.
3. Respect all levels of authority represented in the School.
4. Display a commendable attitude and speech at all time.
5. Fully comply with the School's Uniform Dress Code and personal grooming.
6. Commit to diligence, honesty and integrity in all academic efforts whether in class or at home.
7. Respect the rights of educators to teach, to co-ordinate activities and to facilitate the full school program.
8. Respect the rights of fellow learners to have education.
9. Respect and protect the community of fellow learners and to honour all relationships.
10. Respect and protect the property of the school, its staff and fellow learners.

Learners are not permitted to have any Cell Phone with them at school and in class. Only in an **emergency** and **as motivated and requested in writing** by the Parents / Guardian, may a learner bring his / her Cell Phone to School. In which event all Cell Phones must be handed in to the educator before start of school in the mornings for safekeeping during the school day.

In the event of e-learning, media and data carrying platforms may only be switched on and used for educational purposes under the direct supervision of the educator.

Discipline will be exerted in all cases where behaviour is inappropriate and always with positive purpose - to define the error, correct the behaviour and prevent future infringement. In the event that a learner chooses not to comply or cooperate he / she may face disciplinary measures leading up to suspension or expulsion.
